



- I. A public merit competition is announced for awarding a prize for the best dissertation from those completed for degree programmes at the Polytechnic School of the University of Seville, read during the academic year 2022-2023. The winner will be awarded EUR 1,000.

- II. The dissertation will be evaluated mainly for its impact on the development of engineering in the agri-food industry, as well as its academic value.

- III. Among other aspects, the following will be taken into consideration:
 - Social, industrial, and business impact
 - Application
 - Industrial mention
 - International mention
 - Grade obtained.
 - Dissemination of the obtained results

- IV. The author of the dissertation may apply for the prize. The application will be marked for the attention of GOYA Chair and submitted electronically by 30 September 2023. The instructions will be published along with the rules on the Chair's website. <http://catedragoya.us.es>

- V. The applicant must send the sign-up form along with the required documentation to: catedragoya@us.es
 - A copy of the dissertation submitted for the prize.
 - A report detailing its merits and what qualifies it for the award, indicating whether the thesis has been submitted to other contests or competitions and, if so, the prizes or grants for which it has been awarded.

- VI. The Award will be decided by the Governing Committee of the Chair, which may be advised by experts it deems appropriate. The Commission may decide to award shared prizes or leave the prize vacant, if deemed appropriate.
- VII. By submitting an application, it is implied the acceptance of these rules and the decisions of the Governing Committee, which shall be final.
